

Final Research Project Part III Presentation Guidelines

Details:

Can be done individually or in groups

Length: 7 minutes (max) per person

Format: your choosing

Prompt:

This presentation is an informal way for you to tell the class about your research project. Your presentation should in some way tell us:

- 1) Your research question
- 2) Some important points from your findings
- 3) Something you learned that surprised you the most in regards to your topic

Additional tips:

--Feel free to be as creative as you like with this assignment. For example, you might choose to draw, paint, dance, sing.

--I encourage students who researched the same medium to work in groups, if desired. This will help us get a good range of ideas about each medium and help you make the presentation as engaging as possible.

--Remember that we will be hearing a lot of presentations over the course of two class periods. Try to think of engaging ways to present your information so as to distinguish yourself from other presentations and to keep your audience engaged.

--Given that your research was all about how your chosen medium or app impacts society, I will give extra credit if you can find some way of creatively incorporating your medium into your presentation.
